CHILDREN, VULNERABLE YOUNG PERSON & VOLUNTEERS POLICY



Updated 01 December 2025

The main risks with young people on the yard are as follows:

- Lack of knowledge of hazards, risks and dangers around the facilities
- Lack of technical knowledge and industry standards
- Lack of physical fitness and strength

This also frequently applies to parents

- The Proprietor must take extra care to enforce SLS rules and industry standards where applicable at all times
- All associates, volunteers, working pupils and work experience placements must read and sign the general SLS Risk Assessment and Safeguarding Policy
- ALL must wear suitable PPE and appropriate clothing for the weather conditions
- ALL must take suitable breaks and eat and drink their OWN PROVIDED food and drink at appropriate times
- All young people must be supervised and only allowed to perform tasks unsupervised when they have been trained to do so
- The gates will be shut into the yard during lesson times
- Appropriate signage on the gates to ensure only helpers, instructors and riders are allowed past the gate
