

CLEANING PROCEDURE

Updated 17 April 2024

1. Handwash/sanitise before and after every interaction with a horse/pony, their tack or feed.
2. Immediate mucking out/sweep of horsebox if used for transportation.
3. Wash out all feed/water buckets after use.
4. Daily wipe down of surface in Site 2 feed room with antibacterial spray.
5. Daily sweeping of yards at Site 1 and Site 2.
6. Daily mucking out of all stables.
7. Weekly cleaning and disinfection of water and feed buckets including outside buckets.
8. Weekly cleaning and disinfection of grooming items/kits.
9. Monthly assessment and cleaning of water troughs.
10. Monthly removal of deep muck heap at Site 2.
11. Bi-monthly (or as required) removal of muck heap(s) using Burt as organised by the Proprietor.
12. It is the Proprietor's responsibility to monitor the use of any cleaning products and/or equipment including the purchase and storage of it.
13. All cleaning products/equipment to be stored in a secure container(s) in the barn.
14. All leatherwork and tack to be oiled and cleaned after every ride by those that have been riding.
15. Tack cleaning items are stored in a sealed box on the outside shelves in the barn, clearly labelled, and is provided by the Proprietor.
16. Muddy boots to be taken off and placed on stands before entering the office.
17. Office cleanliness is the Proprietor's responsibility only.
18. Riding hats to be sprayed with helmet deodorant (stored on helmet shelf) after every use.
19. Body protectors to be hung up on the rail after use.
20. Toilet to be regularly serviced by Euroloo (Proprietor to organise).
21. Toilet to be checked daily and monitored for cleanliness.
