

CLEANING PROCEDURE

Updated 17 April 2024

- 1. Handwash/sanitise before and after every interaction with a horse/pony, their tack or feed.
- 2. Immediate mucking out/sweep of horsebox if used for transportation.
- 3. Wash out all feed/water buckets after use.
- 4. Daily wipe down of surface in Site 2 feed room with antibacterial spray.
- 5. Daily sweeping of yards at Site 1 and Site 2.
- 6. Daily mucking out of all stables.
- Weekly cleaning and disinfection of water and feed buckets including outside buckets.
- 8. Weekly cleaning and disinfection of grooming items/kits.
- 9. Monthly assessment and cleaning of water troughs.
- 10. Monthly removal of deep muck heap at Site 2.
- 11. Bi-monthly (or as required) removal of muck heap(s) using Burt as organised by the Proprietor.
- 12. It is the Proprietor's responsibility to monitor the use of any cleaning products and/or equipment including the purchase and storage of it.
- 13. All cleaning products/equipment to be stored in a secure container(s) in the barn.
- 14. All leatherwork and tack to be oiled and cleaned after every ride by those that have been riding.
- 15. Tack cleaning items are stored in a sealed box on the outside shelves in the barn, clearly labelled, and is provided by the Proprietor.
- 16. Muddy boots to be taken off and placed on stands before entering the office.
- 17. Office cleanliness is the Proprietor's responsibility only.
- 18. Riding hats to be sprayed with helmet deodorant (stored on helmet shelf) after every use.
- 19. Body protectors to be hung up on the rail after use.
- 20. Toilet to be regularly serviced by Euroloo (Proprietor to organise).
- 21. Toilet to be checked daily and monitored for cleanliness.
